From education policy to education administration, U.S. colleges and universities offer comprehensive programs in the field education. If your career goal revolves around implementing educational policies, conducting research in education or administrating student programming at colleges and universities, then look towards obtaining your education degree abroad in the United States.



Important Information for Canadian Students

- Start researching your options with search engines like petersons.com, or gradschools.com
- When it comes to programs in education, there are three main distinctions that you should consider: policy, research and practice. Your program and school selection will largely depend on which of the three specializations best relate to your eventual career goal in education.
- When applying to either undergraduate or graduate education programs at U.S. colleges and universities, Canadian applicants may need to pass an [English proficiency test](#) (depending on eligible exemptions). Graduate applicants need to also take the [GRE](#) test – view [example education program application requirements](#).
- Canadian students may qualify for certain merit scholarships at individual colleges and universities. These qualification and availability largely depend on the specific school you are interested in. For instance, Canadian students may qualify for the [University of Michigan](#)
- [School of Education institutional grants and scholarships](#). [Research funding](#) support is also available.
