

Important Information for Canadian Students

- Research graduate options with search engines like petersons.com or gradschools.com.
- Finding the engineering specialty that is right for you revolves around your career goals. Read articles related to different fields in engineering to get a sense of career options after completing your program – [civil](#), [chemical](#), [electrical](#), [mechanical](#).
- When applying to engineering programs at American colleges and universities, Canadian applicants, both undergraduate and graduate, may need to pass an [English proficiency test](#) (depending on eligible exemptions). Graduate applicants need to also take the [GRE](#) test.
- Canadian students may qualify for certain merit scholarships. These qualification and availability largely depends on the specific school in which you are interested. For example, Canadian students may qualify for [New York University engineering school](#)'s institutional scholarships and grants, which are based on financial need and academic merit.
- Ensure that the program you are applying to will be recognized by your provincial Professional Engineer's Association. For example, [APEGA](#) regulates Alberta's professional engineers.
