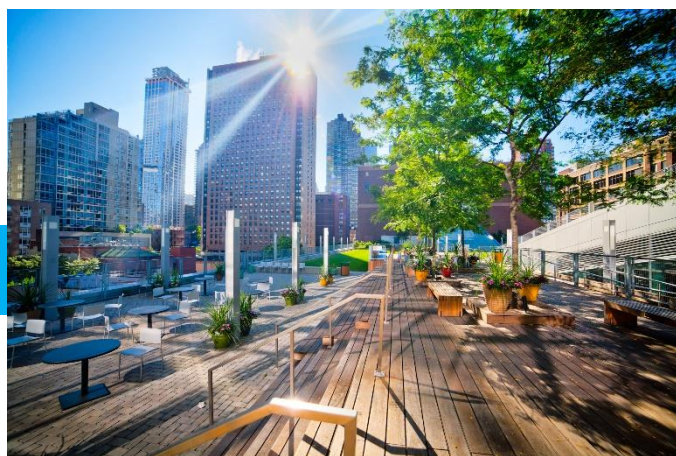
# John Jay College
