Transylvania University

in Lexington, Kentucky

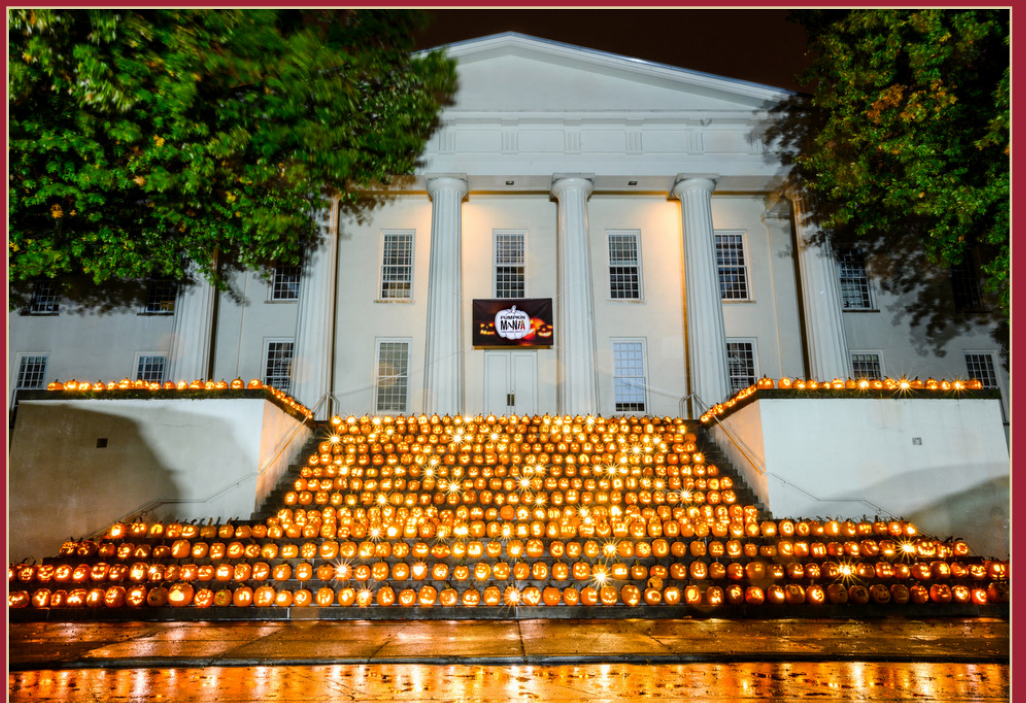
Founded in 1780 as the 16th-oldest college in the United States, Transylvania University (Transy) is a highly ranked liberal arts college in the heart of downtown Lexington, Kentucky. Transy is a challenging, relationship-rich university with an engaging faculty that encourages community-driven students to achieve personal fulfillment and professional success.

Lexington, Kentucky —the Horse Capital of the World — is a thriving, centrally located city of 300,000 people. Transylvania's downtown location makes it easy for students to get jobs and internships in a variety of sectors, including business, medicine, law, the arts and much more. Additionally, the university enjoys a number of



partnerships with local community organizations that allow its active student body to participate in civic engagement.

Transylvania offers 46 majors, plus the ability for students to design their own. Professors work closely with their students, providing an individualized education and offering opportunities for students to research, co-publish and even teach with them. The





personal attention provided to Transylvania students gives them a leg up — 95% are employed or in graduate school within six months of graduating, including a 90% admission rate into medical school and 100% admission rate into law school for recommended students. Students are guided one-on-one throughout their college career and into the job search process by successful alumni mentors through the unique 100 Doors to Success Mentorship Program.

Transylvania University's campus has undergone a near-complete revitalization over the past 10 years. Transy has seen the construction of three new suite-style residence halls, a complete renovation of its main humanities building, and it is nearing completion of the construction of a state-of-the-art campus center that will be the main hub of student life. The dining hall recently partnered with food service provider Bon Appetit, which specializes in local food and farm-to-table dining, with an emphasis on healthy eating and limited food waste.
